

# SEPTEMBER 1, 2010 CONSTRUCTION BEGINS! LAVWMA WESTERN TERMINUS PIPELINE



The **Livermore Amador Valley Water Management Agency (LAVWMA)** will begin constructing the final link of the 16-mile Export Facilities Pipeline. The Western Terminus connects the LAVWMA pipeline into the East Bay Discharge Authority's (EBDA) pipeline here in Roberts Landing. The proposed pipeline is just under 2,000 feet long and replaces the original pipeline built in 1979. With normal deterioration, this segment is reaching the end of its safe operating life under normal LAVWMA flow conditions.

Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) techniques will enable the pipeline to **pass under the restored marshlands** to protect the wetland habitat in the area. The new pipeline would parallel the existing LAVWMA pipeline which would be abandoned in place, also to prevent disruption to the marsh. **Construction is September 1<sup>st</sup> – January 15<sup>th</sup>.**
